### Marks Distribution of Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC) and Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) for Education (Honours/General) Courses of Studies under CBCS:

#### A) Marks Distribution of Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC): 80 Marks

- 20 questions of 2 marks each :  $20 \times 2 = 40$  marks
- 3 questions of 10 marks each out of 6 questions :  $3 \times 10 = 30$  marks
- 2 short notes of 5 marks :  $2 \times 5 = 10$  marks

#### B) Marks Distribution of Discipline Specific Elective (DSE): 65 Marks

- 15 questions of 2 marks each :  $15 \times 2 = 30$  marks
- 3 questions of 10 marks each out of 6 questions :  $3 \times 10 = 30$  marks
- 1 short note of 5 marks :  $1 \times 5 = 5$  marks

The above shall take effect for all concerned semesters and will start from semester-4 examination, 2020.


